THUNDER BAY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE RECOGNIZED AS AN ACCREDITED CHAMBER

The Thunder Bay Chamber of Commerce was recognized as an accredited Chamber of Commerce for an additional period of three years. This accreditation was first received in September 2006.

Accreditation is a formal acknowledgement that member chambers/boards of trade have been successfully evaluated by the Chamber Accreditation Council of Canada (CACC) against rigorous national standards of policy, service and performance. The CACC, which meets twice a year to review applications for accreditation, represents provincial, territorial and national chambers of commerce.

Attaining accreditation means that individually, and collectively, chambers reflect to the larger community - both domestic and international - a renewed and reinvigorated sense of purpose and direction, reclaiming their pride of place as the leading business representative in the broader market.

“We were both surprised and pleased when we were one of only two Ontario Chambers to receive this award at the recent Ontario Chambers of Commerce annual general meeting,” stated Mary Long-Irwin.
